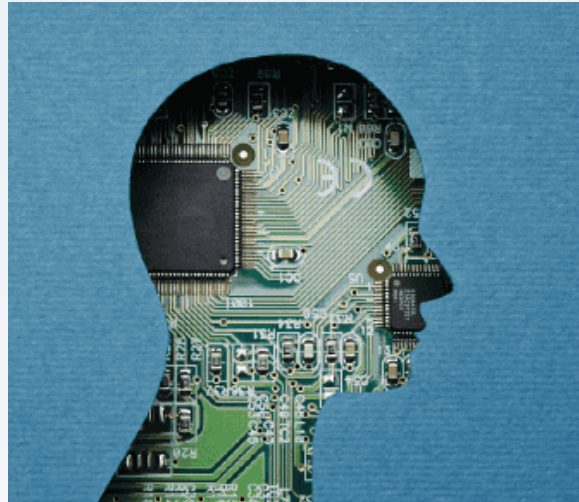

There were a total of 12 nurse led project teams that submitted abstracts. There were three North and three Central reviewers who conducted a blinded ranking of proposals. Congratulations to our two awardees. The Nursing Research Abstract was awarded for the project “Chronic Pain and Effects of Self-Regulation and Mindfulness” and the team consists of Debra Kahnen, RN, CMSRN, and Marygrace Hernandez-Leveille, PhD, RN, ACNP-BC from Baylor University Medical Center, Dallas. The project “Nurse Led Inpatient Acute Stroke Response: Utilizing a Rapid Response Team as a Team Lead for an Inpatient Acute Stroke Alert” received the EBP award.
